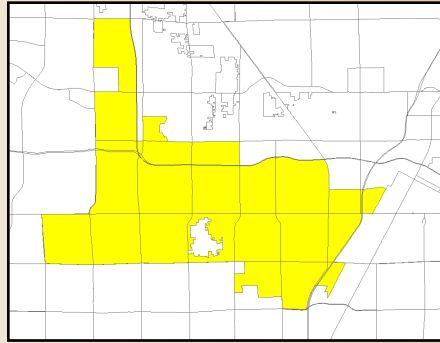

# WARD 1

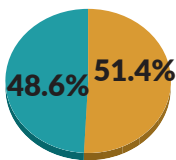

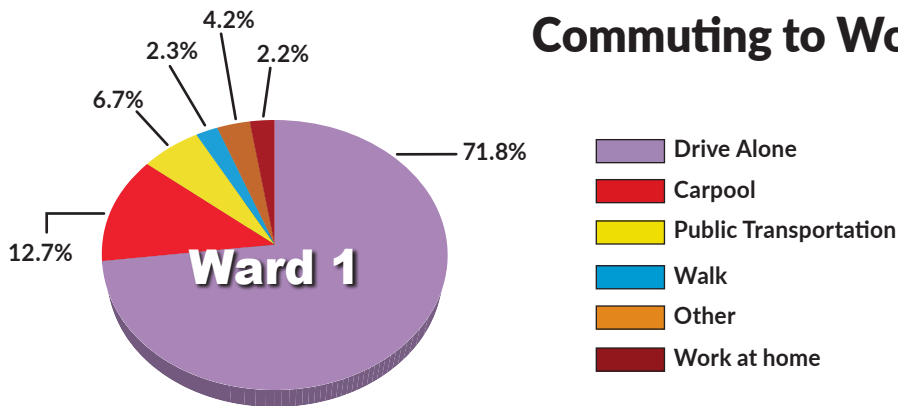


## Residential Construction Year Built



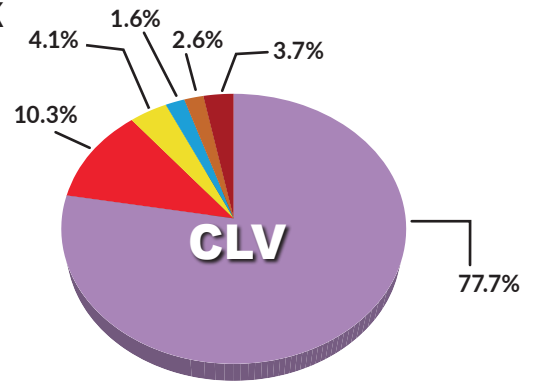

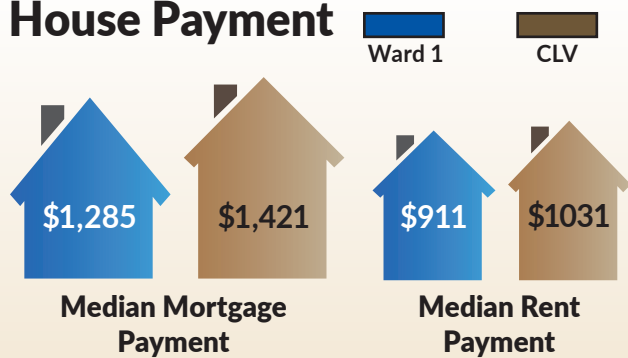
Mean Time Travel to Work Ward 1 - 21.9 minutes

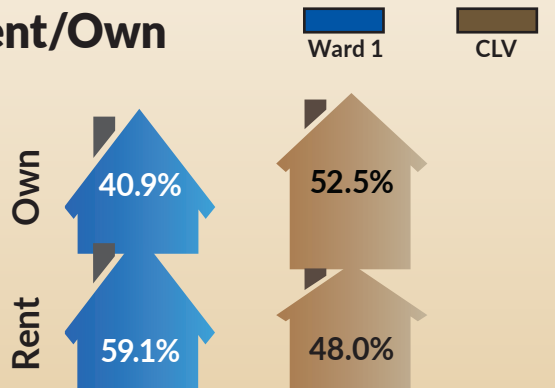


Mean Time Travel to Work CLV - 24.7 minutes

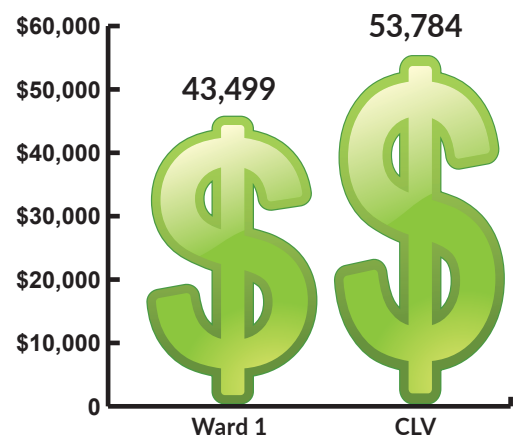

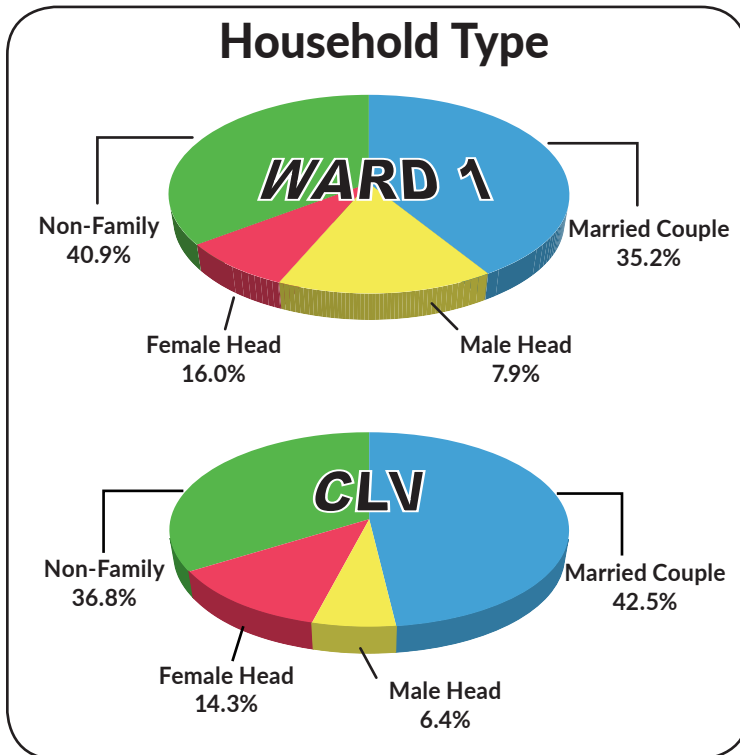
