In recent years, downtown Las Vegas has experienced a tremendous amount of revitalization, transforming into one of the most dynamic, interesting and diverse parts of the city. Downtown has become an exciting food and beverage district, where many of the city's best and hippest new restaurants, bars, retail and microbreweries have opened in recent years, as well as an eclectic mix of old and new boutiques, galleries and other businesses.

Check out the creative collection of visual artists, writers and musicians in the Arts District and the Fremont East Entertainment District, and explore downtown's street gallery comprised of hundreds of murals and installation pieces from the Las Vegas Centennial, First Friday, Life Is Beautiful Festival and more. Stop into one of the area's nationally recognized cocktail bars where they're handcrafting some of the country's finest cocktails.

Visit uniquely Vegas museums, from The Mob Museum to the cultural corridor's Neon Museum and Old Mormon Fort. Take in classic lights in the city's original strip, the Fremont Street Experience. Enjoy a huge collection of luxury brands at the Las Vegas Premium Outlet mall, or venture a couple of blocks east to Main Street to peruse the city's best retro and vintage shops.

Downtown Las Vegas also serves as a hub for tech businesses, and is home to modern architecture like the Frank Gehry-designed Cleveland Clinic Lou Ruvo Center for Brain Health. A central area for the city's legal and justice industries, downtown is also home to Las Vegas City Hall, county and transportation services, and more.

Vintage Vegas experiences are also preserved throughout downtown, from old-school, fine-dining restaurants that once welcomed the Rat Pack to Las Vegas' oldest freestanding bar to throwback slot machines and games like Sigma Derby that still take coins.

If you visit on the first weekend of the month, check out First Friday, Las Vegas' monthly art and music experience. Then hit the streets on foot or bike to befriend an engaging mix of locals and visitors. Only then will you be a true downtowner.

A new attraction added last year is Fear the Walking Dead: Survival, at Fremont Street Experience, a first-of-its-kind experience inspired by AMC's Fear the Walking Dead TV series. Upon entering, guests are transported to the world of Fear the Walking Dead, set against a temporary military medical facility amid growing rumors of a zombie outbreak.

DOWNTOWNER INSIDER'S GUIDE TO FOOD

Downtown Las Vegas' dining is evolving so fast, it'll likely change by the time you finish reading this sentence. But we won't jump ahead just yet. Long-lasting casino favorites like Binion's Steak House, Vic & Anthony's at the Golden Nugget, and Hugo's Cellar still hold a special charm. And Fremont's Paradise Buffet and Café, Oscar's Steakhouse at The Plaza, and Siegel's 1941 at the El Cortez deliver that classic Las Vegas vibe in quality, quantity and décor. The Triple 7 Restaurant and Microbrewery at Main Street Station remains a popular spot for its fresh brews and big menu, and The Redwood Steakhouse is a fine dining experience not to be missed. For a classic Italian menu that's anything but basic, there's Joe Vicari's Andiamo Italian Steakhouse at the D Las Vegas, and for a different kind of restaurant that answers Downtown Las Vegas' desire for a new food experience and attract music lovers – there's Freedom Beat at Downtown Grand, with live musical performances and 24-hour dining. Finally, you'd be remiss not to stop in at Lappert's Ice Cream for its perfect blend of creamy treats.

All that being said, the downtown renaissance of cocktail lounges and stylish hangouts has been complemented by a wave of great new restaurants.

You'll find elements of the current farm-to-table cuisine movement downtown. The variety of choices found there appeal to everyone's tastes, no matter how particular they might be. There's gourmet pizza; gastropubs; thoughtful Thai; an abundance of great burgers; nouveau Mexican; dining in the dark; and vegan food so good, it will even appeal to meat lovers. And it's getting better by the minute, with new restaurants constantly popping up, like 7th & Carson, which aspires to be a nice little drinking spot with great food.

With places like these, it's clear that the best restaurants in Las Vegas are no longer just on the Strip. A bold crop of eateries are taking over the city's "best of" lists, like The Smashed Pig and its unexpected mixture of adventurous bites, British staples and craft beers that are anything but typical. Downtown's dining scene is also home to a growing group of fiercely talented chefs who recently left some of the Strip's finest restaurants to create something new, like chef Su, who left the kitchens of Joël Robuchon to open the one-of-a-kind Flock & Fowl, where he obsesses over making the most perfect plate of Hainanese chicken rice you'll ever have. Mission accomplished.

There's an impressive diversity to downtown's offerings as well. Indian food with a modern take at turmeric; inspired Italian soul food in the Arts District at Esther's Kitchen; a slice of Hawaiian pizza at Evel Pie that's guaranteed to be unlike anything you've had before; and a delicious meal and a fresh-squeezed juice at Rachel's Kitchen.

With so many options and such delicious food to try, there's never been a better time to take a trip downtown to satisfy your culinary curiosity. Go there hungry, and leave happy.
